

I. GENERAL RULES

1. Visitors may enter the premises of the SOLARIS NSRC under the supervision of a SOLARIS staff representative only.
2. Any person visiting the building is obliged to report their arrival to a security guard at the entrance to the building.
3. Due to the risk of ionizing radiation and the nature of operation of SOLARIS, visitors should exercise extreme caution and follow the instructions of SOLARIS employees.
4. It is prohibited to enter accelerator laboratories and other locations marked with the following signs without the permission of a SOLARIS employee:



5. It is also prohibited to enter zones marked with a tape or a warning chain.
6. The SOLARIS NSRC is a completely no-smoking area, except for areas specifically designed for this purpose, located in front of the building.
7. It is strictly prohibited to use open fire in SOLARIS.
8. Persons remaining under the influence of drugs or alcohol or behaving in a way that endangers safety, disrupts sightseeing, or violates generally accepted standards of behaviour in public places are not allowed to enter the SOLARIS Centre.
9. The SOLARIS Centre has the right to demand visitors who violate public order or knowingly and flagrantly violate the Rules to leave the facility.
10. In the case of emergency evacuation, visitors are obliged to leave the building following the evacuation route signs and SOLARIS Centre employees' instructions.
11. Commercial or promotional activities are prohibited in the SOLARIS Centre.

II. GENERAL RULES OF VISITING THE SOLARIS CENTRE

1. The SOLARIS NSRC is a research facility. That is why we reserve the right to close the facility for visitors or to introduce restrictions on sightseeing without prior notice in cases justified by security or organizational issues.
2. Detailed information about the days and hours when visits are possible can be found at www.synchrotron.uj.edu.pl. The date of the visit can also be set by phone, contacting an authorized SOLARIS NSRC employee.
3. The person authorized to set the date of the visit is Mrs Alicja Górkiewicz (phone: +48 12 664 41 99; +48 571 445 045, e-mail: alicja.gorkiewicz@uj.edu.pl).
4. Visits to the SOLARIS NRSC are possible only after prior appointment and the number of visitors has to be declared in advance.
5. The duration and programme of the visit depend on the age of the visitors and machine status. The average duration of a trip is 1 to 2 hours.
6. Visits to the SOLARIS NRSC are free.
7. Visits to the SOLARIS Centre are possible only for organized groups. Individual visitors are cordially invited to take part in the Małopolska Scientists' Night, information days, Innovation Fest or similar events. Detailed information on the event can be found at www.synchrotron.uj.edu.pl.
8. Children under the age of thirteen may visit SOLARIS only under the supervision of persons with full legal capacity. The guardians are fully liable. They are also responsible for the supervised persons, and for the damage caused by them.
9. It is allowed and free to take pictures and film at the SOLARIS NRSC.
10. Animals may not enter the SOLARIS Centre. The exception is guide dogs for blind or visually impaired people.
11. Large luggage is not allowed in the SOLARIS Centre. Visitors will be asked to leave larger bags at a safe guard room.
12. SOLARIS Centre employees are not liable for any items lost by visitors.
13. Prior to the visit, it is necessary for the organizer to indicate the person responsible for the group. The person must provide a list of names of visitors and a signed declaration, as per Appendix 1 to the Rules.

III. SAFETY RULES

1. The premises of the SOLARIS NRSC and all objects on the premises are an integral whole protected by the law. It is prohibited to move, remove, or destroy any objects located in the SOLARIS Centre.
2. The number of visitors on the premises of the SOLARIS NRSC at one time may not exceed 30 people (with one guardian).
3. The tour is guided by a SOLARIS Centre employee. It is strictly prohibited to leave the group and move around the facility on your own.

4. Groups shall follow the route designated by the SOLARIS NRSC employee. The tour route depends on the current status of the synchrotron. It is, therefore, determined on a daily basis and may be modified at any moment.
5. Guardians of the groups are liable for the behaviour of their members.
6. Guardians of the groups are responsible for following the instructions of SOLARIS employees and maintaining discipline in the group.
7. Guardians of the groups and the guide should stay in close proximity to the participants at all times.
8. It is strictly prohibited to touch machines, devices, and electrical installations.
9. Each visitor is obliged to follow instructions of the employee guiding the trip.
10. For security reasons, SOLARIS security staff have the right to inspect personal luggage. Visitors who refuse to undergo an inspection or leave their luggage in a place designated by a SOLARIS Centre employee will not be allowed to enter the building.
11. It is prohibited to bring weapons and objects posing a threat to life, health, and general safety to the SOLARIS facility.
12. The SOLARIS Centre shall not be liable for accidents resulting from the health status or intentional actions of visitors.
13. At the end of the tour, the guardian of the trip is obliged to check whether all participants have left the facility.
