# Regulations of the contest "Christmas contest #photoofSOLARIS"

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### **General information**

- 1. These Regulations (hereinafter: "Regulations") define the conditions of participation in the Contest "Christmas contest #photoofSOLARIS".
- 2. The Organizer of the Contest and the pledgee of the prize is the Jagiellonian University National Synchrotron Radiation Centre SOLARIS, (hereinafter: "Organizer").
- 3. The participant of the Contest (hereinafter referred to as "Participant") may be any person who has full legal capacity. Persons with limited legal capacity shall participate in the Contest with the consent of their legal representative or legal guardian.
- 4. Participants of the Contest cannot be current employees of the Organizer employed in NSRC SOLARIS located at 98 Czerwone Maki Street, 30-392 Krakow or persons who are in a civil law relationship with the Organizer.
- 5. The Contest **begins on 14.12.2022 and ends on 13.01.2023** (this is the day of announcing the Contest Winners).
- 6. Entries to the contest will be accepted from 14.12.2022 to 31.12.2022.
- 7. Voting for photographs shall take place from 03.01.2023 to 12.01.2023.
- 8. Participation in the Contest is free of charge and completely voluntary.
- 9. All costs associated with participation in the Contest shall be borne by the participant himself.

### §Ⅱ

### Rules of participation in the Contest and the contest task

- 1. The contest task is to send a photograph related to the SOLARIS National Synchrotron Radiation Centre, of promotional and informational nature or reportage.
- 2. The subject matter of the competition photograph should be related to the SOLARIS National Synchrotron Radiation Centre research facility.
- 3. The photograph for the contest may not contain illegal content, commonly regarded as vulgar and offensive, containing pornography, eroticism, obscene scenes, offending the feelings of others, including religious feelings, depicting violence or racist materials, violating the right to privacy, containing materials protected by the rights of other entities without

the consent of these authorized entities, symbols having ambiguous meaning. The contest task must not violate the good name and image of the Jagiellonian University.

- 4. The competition photograph must be saved in jpg format.
- 5. The submitted contest photographs will be shared on the Facebook profile of NSRC SOLARIS https://www.facebook.com/synchrotron.solaris.badania in the contest post marked #photoofSOLARIS.
- 6. To become a Participant, you must meet the following conditions:
- a) submit your participation by the deadline specified in §I item 5 of the Regulations, according to the rules specified in §III of the Regulations (hereinafter: "Submission"),
- b) meet the requirements referred to in the Regulations,
- c) accept the Regulations,
- d) perform the Contest task in accordance with the Regulations and deliver the Contest task to the Organizer by sending it to the email address specified in the Regulations.
- 7. The Contest Participant may only be an adult with full legal capacity, meeting the requirements referred to in §1 item 3 of the Regulations.
- 8. The author of the contest task can be only one person, coauthored works can not be submitted to the Contest.
- 9. Each Participant may submit at most one competition photograph.
- 10. By submitting a contest task, the Participant declares that he has full rights to the contest task and that it is an original work, not published anywhere, is not a copy or adaptation of already existing works and does not infringe on the rights of third parties.
- 11. If images of third parties have been used in the contest task, the Participant shall ensure that he/she has the permission of these persons to use their image and its use in the contest task by the Organizer under the terms of these Regulations. For this purpose, the participant shall provide a form of consent for the use of the image, which constitutes Appendix No. 2 of the Regulations, together with the e-mail referred to in §III item 1.
- 12. The Participant shall be liable for claims of third parties regarding violation of copyright, personal rights, right of publicity and other rights regarding the use of legally protected elements in the contest task. In the event that third parties make the claims referred to in the preceding sentence, the Participant shall release the Organizer from any claims made by such third parties and shall assume responsibility for the aforementioned claims.
- 13. By participating in the contest, the winner agrees that the organizer may later use the contest task for promotional purposes in whole or in part by marking the authorship of the contest task, as agreed with the winner.

14. The Entrant agrees not to dispose of the rights to the Contest task or encumber it in such a way that would make it impossible to fulfill the provisions of the Regulations.

15. No Participant will be admitted to the Contest who does not meet the conditions set forth in the Regulations and/or whose Contest tasks do not meet the requirements set forth in the Regulations. Persons who submitted their Application after the deadline provided in the Regulations or whose Application was incomplete will not be admitted to the Contest.

### ξIII

### Rules for submitting the contest task and Application

- 1. Entry to the contest is made by sending the contest task to the Organizer's e-mail address: <a href="mailto:solaris.pr@uj.edu.pl">solaris.pr@uj.edu.pl</a> in the title of the message writing: "Christmas contest #photoofSOLARIS". The e-mail with the contest task must contain in its content the information and statements indicated in Attachment No. 1 to the Regulations, and if the photograph will contain the image of third parties, then it will be necessary to attach to the e-mail a form of consent for the use of image constituting Attachment No. 2 to the Regulations.
- 2. An e-mail, referred to in the above paragraph, which does not contain all the statements from Appendix No. 1 to the Regulations, or, if applicable, which does not have a correctly filled out consent form for the use of the image, cannot be considered as an Application. Entries shall be accepted only by electronic means, in the manner specified in paragraph 1 above. 3.
- 3. The final date for acceptance of the works is **31.12.2022, at 11:59 p.m.** The date of receipt of the e-mail message shall determine the date of the Entry.
- 4. The Organizer shall not be responsible for delays in the delivery of e-mails. The Organizer is also not responsible for the actions of third parties, not related to the organization of the Contest, and for damages caused by incorrect or outdated data provided by the Participants.
- 5. It is not possible to make changes to the Entry or the Contest task after the Entry has been made. Upon acceptance of the Entry by the Organizer, the Participant grants the Organizer a non-exclusive license to the Contest task (photograph) under the terms specified in §VII.

## § IV Selection of works

1. From among the shared photos (§II item 5), the Contest Committee will select 3 with the highest number of reactions, which will be posted on the Organizer's website and the Organizer's social media profiles.

- 2. The authors of the winning photographs will be awarded prizes according to the following rules.
- 3. The contest will be supervised by the contest committee, consisting of: Agnieszka Cudek, Kinga Wróbel, Joanna Kowalik (hereinafter: "Commission").
- 4. The tasks of the Commission shall also include evaluation of the correctness of the Applications.
- 5. The decision of the Commission is final and cannot be appealed.
- 6. The Commission shall prepare minutes of the meeting with the results.

# § V Announcement of the results

- 1. The winning competition photographs will be indicated by the Commission by 13.01.2023.
- 2. Participants who are the authors of the winning contest photographs will be informed by the Organizer about the winning by e-mail. The Organizer reserves the right not to inform the authors of the contest tasks that have not been awarded about the settlement of the Contest.
- 3. The Organizer is not obliged to inform the other Participants about the results of the Contest.

## § VI Award

1.The authors of the highest-scoring contest tasks will be awarded prizes:

- a) 1st place NSRC SOLARIS 2023 wall calendar, NSRC SOLARIS 2023 book calendar, powerbank with NSRC SOLARIS logo, mug with NSRC SOLARIS logo, other small gadgets at the discretion of the Organizer.
- b) 2nd place wall calendar NSRC SOLARIS 2023, book calendar 2023, large flashlight with NSRC SOLARIS logo, mug with NSRC SOLARIS logo, other gadgets at the discretion of the Organizer.
- c) 3rd place NSRC SOLARIS 2023 wall calendar, book calendar 2023, small flashlight with NSRC SOLARIS logo, mug with NSRC SOLARIS logo, other gadgets at the discretion of the Organizer.
- 2. Due to the content of the Act of July 26, 1991 on personal income tax, prizes are not taxable. The participant cannot transfer the right to the prize to third parties.

- 3. The Organizer is not responsible for incorrect data indicated by the Participant, in particular, for the change of personal data that makes it impossible to find the Participant and inform about the awarding of the prize. In case of change of personal data, the Participant is obliged to inform the Organizer about it.
- 4. The Organizer reserves the right not to award prizes or to award a smaller number of prizes in the event that the submitted contest tasks do not meet the formal or substantive criteria specified in these Regulations, are delivered to the Organizer after the entry deadline, or if the person entering the Contest does not meet the conditions to be a Participant.
- 5. Applications that do not comply with the Regulations will not be admitted to the Contest.
- 6. Participants are not entitled to separate remuneration for the use of the contest task in each separate field of exploitation.
- 7. The Participant, upon acceptance of the Entry by the Organizer, grants the Organizer a license to the Competition task (photograph), in the following fields of exploitation:
- a) consolidation and reproduction of the competition task production of copies using all available techniques, including printing, reprography, magnetic recording and digital techniques (including DVD, magneto-optical media);
- b) permanent or temporary reproduction in whole or in part by any means and in any form;
- c) in terms of dissemination exhibition, display, reproduction, as well as broadcasting and re-broadcasting, as well as making available to the public in such a way that everyone can have access to the competition task at a place and time of their own choosing, using all available techniques, including use on the Internet, Intranet and other computer networks, posting and modification of the competition task on websites, broadcasting with the help of a multimedia and ICT network, modifications allowing to create navigation on websites, making available to the public at publicly accessible exhibitions or expositions;
- d) re-broadcasting, dissemination in the press, on the Internet, on large-format posters and in any other form of promotion or advertising;
- 8. The license granted to the Organizer by the Participant for the use of the competition task is free of charge, non-exclusive and unlimited as to territory. The license is granted for a period of 3 months. The license includes permission to grant sublicenses within the scope of the granted license.

# § VII Protection of personal data

Pursuant to Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC

(General Data Protection Regulation, hereinafter "GDPR"), Jagiellonian University informs you that:

- 1. the controller of your personal data is the Jagiellonian University, 24 Gołębia Street, 31-007 Kraków, represented by the Rector of the Jagiellonian University.
- 2. the Jagiellonian University has appointed a Data Protection Inspector, 4 Czapskich St., 31-110 Krakow, room no. 27. The Inspector can be contacted by e-mail: iod@uj.edu.pl or at telephone number 12 663 12 25, Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm.
- 3. your personal data provided in the Application will be processed:
- a) for all Participants:

i. for the purpose of organizing, conducting the Contest and announcing the results of the Contest on the basis of Article 6, Paragraph 1, Letter f GDPR-i.e. for the purpose of realizing the legitimate interest of the Organizer, which is to conduct the Contest in accordance with the Regulations accepted by the Participants;

ii. to conclude and execute the license agreement granted by the Participant by submitting the Entry- on the basis of Article 6, Paragraph 1, Letter b GDPR;

iii. for the purpose of fulfilling the legal obligations imposed on the Organizer as the pledgee of the prize, including primarily the obligation to honor author's moral rights, i.e. on the basis of Article 6, Paragraph 1, Letter c of the GDPR;

iv. in order to assert and defend against possible claims, which is the legitimate interest of the Organizer - i.e. on the basis of Article 6, Paragraph 1, Letter f GDPR.

#### b) in the case of Winners:

i. in order to announce the results of the Contest on the basis of Article 6, Paragraph 1, Letter f GDPR-i.e. in order to realize the legitimate interest of the Organizer, which is to conduct the Contest and announce its results in accordance with the Regulations accepted by the Participants;

ii. in order to comply with the legal obligations imposed on the Organizer as the prize pledger, including primarily tax obligations and the obligation to honor author's moral rights, i.e. on the basis of Article 6, Paragraph 1, Letter c GDPR;

iii. for the purpose of asserting and defending against possible claims, which is the legitimate interest of the Organizer - i.e. on the basis of Article 6, Paragraph 1, Letter f of the GDPR.

4. Your provision of personal data is voluntary, but necessary to participate in the Contest. The consequence of not providing personal data will be the inability to participate in the Contest. In the case of Participants referred to in item. 3 lit. b above, providing the data is a legal obligation, and failure to do so will make it impossible to award the Participant and conclude the agreement indicated therein.

- 5. The personal data of the Participants referred to in item. 3 letter a above will not be shared with third parties. Personal data of Participants referred to in item. 3 lit. b, item I above (data identifying the Winners) will be posted on the Organizer's website and in the Organizer's social media in consideration of marking the authorship of the contest tasks and honoring the author's moral rights.
- 6. Your personal data will not be transferred to third countries (outside the European Economic Area) or to international organizations.
- 7. Personal data of Participants referred to in item. 3 letter a above will be processed for the duration of the license granted to the Organizer, and then for the period of limitation of claims, in accordance with generally applicable regulations.
- 8. The personal data of the Participants referred to in item. 3(b) above will be processed for the period provided for by tax regulations and the period of limitation of claims in accordance with applicable regulations.
- 9. You have the right to: obtain information about the processing of your personal data and your rights under the GDPR, access to and rectification of the content of your data, as well as the right to delete your personal data from the controller's files (unless further processing is necessary for the performance of a legal obligation or for the purpose of establishing, pursuing or defending claims), and the right to restrict processing, data portability, object to processing in the cases and under the conditions specified in the GDPR.
- 10. Your personal data will not be subject to automated decision-making or profiling.
- 11. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Office of Personal Data Protection if you consider that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR.

# § VIII Final provisions

- 1. These Regulations are available at https://synchrotron.uj.edu.pl/.
- 2. In the case of detection of actions inconsistent with the Regulations, including attempts to influence the selection of the winner in an unauthorized manner, a given Participant shall be excluded from the Contest.
- 3. All complaints and comments regarding the rules, conduct or settlement of the Contest should be submitted by e-mail to: solaris.pr@uj.edu.pl. The complaint should include the name of the Participant and the reason for the complaint. Complaints are considered within 30 days from the date of receiving the email.
- 4. The Organizer reserves the right to cancel or invalidate the Contest at any time, and reserves the right to change the Regulations in accordance with the provisions below.
- 5. The Organizer will announce the cancellation of the Contest or changes to the Regulations on the Contest website and by e-mail.

- 6. The Organizer may cancel the Contest if no Contest tasks have been received or those that have been received do not meet the requirements specified in the Regulations.
- 7. The Organizer may change the Regulations only for a valid reason and to the extent that the change does not aggravate the situation of the Participants and does not violate the essential principles of the Contest. Participants will be notified of changes to the Rules in advance, allowing them to familiarize themselves with the changes and withdraw from the Contest without consequences for the Participant. The Organizer may also amend the Rules by correcting errors and clerical mistakes.
- 8. The Organizer may invalidate the Contest if it is discovered that the Contestants' influence on the results of the Contest is inconsistent with the Regulations.
- 9. In all matters not covered by these Regulations, the provisions of generally applicable law shall apply, including the relevant provisions of the Civil Code and the Law on Copyright and Related Rights.
- 10. The social network Facebook is not responsible for the organization and conduct of the "Christmas contest #photoofSOLARIS".
- 11. All inquiries related to the organization of the Contest should be addressed to: solaris.pr@uj.edu.pl.

### Appendix No. 1 to the Competition Regulations

### **CONTENT OF THE APPLICATION**

1. Data of the Contest participant
First and last name of the author
3. Statements
a) I declare that I have familiarized myself with the Regulations of the Competition

b) I declare that I created the Contest task on my own, it is original and does not violate the rights, good name and image of the Jagiellonian University, as well as any rights of third parties, in particular does not violate the property and personal copyrights of third parties, their right to image or personal rights.

I am aware that, in accordance with the provisions of the Regulations, I am liable for claims by third parties regarding infringement of copyright, personal rights, right of publicity and other rights regarding the use of legally protected elements in the contest task. In the event that third parties make the claims referred to in the preceding sentence, I will indemnify the Organizer from any claims made by such third parties and will cover any damages that the Contest Organizer will incur due to claims made by third parties regarding the submitted Contest task.

In addition, I agree not to dispose of the rights to the contest task or encumber it in such a way that would make it impossible to fulfill the provisions of the Regulations.

- c) I declare that in case of acceptance of this application by the Organizer, I grant to the Organizer a non-exclusive license to the Competition task within the meaning of the Act of February 4, 1994 on copyright and related rights under the terms of the Regulations.
- d) I declare that I agree to use the Competition task for the purposes and to the extent related to the conduct and settlement of the Competition, in accordance with the principles specified in the Regulations.
- e) I declare that I am not an employee of the Organizer or in a civil law relationship with him.

- 9. You also have the right to withdraw your consent at any time without affecting the legality of processing carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal. You can withdraw your consent to the processing of personal data:
