

Processing of personal data

In accordance with Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation, hereinafter the "General Regulations"), the Jagiellonian University (JU) reports that:

1. Your personal data shall be controlled by the Jagiellonian University, address: ul. Gołębia 24, 31-007 Krakow, represented by the Rector of the JU.

3. Your personal data (name, surname, academic title, affiliation, country of origin, contact e-mail, office phone number) will be processed in order to properly carry out **the Light for Ukraine** project, (especially to enable NSRC SOLARIS UJ act as a Information Point), i.e. performance of the contract, i.e. pursuant to Art. 6 sec. 1 let. b GDPR, on the basis of agreement concluded by filling the information forms on the Project webpage.
4. Providing data is voluntary, but if you don't provide it, it won't be possible to register your offer or to be informed about important events related to the Light for Ukraine project.
5. Your personal data may be made available to entities authorized to receive them on the basis of generally applicable law.
6. Your personal data will be entrusted under the personal data entrustment agreement pursuant to Art. 28 GDPR, to the relevant IT services Suppliers of the JU.
7. Your personal data will not be transferred to third countries (outside the European Economic Area) or to international organizations.
8. Personal data of Participants will be kept for the duration of the Light for Ukraine project and until the claims that may arise.
9. If you want to post a notice Your personal data (name, surname, name of the parent entity, academic title, contact e-mail, office phone number) may be published at Project webpage (e.g. https://synchrotron.uj.edu.pl/en_GB/lightforukraine) in order to fulfill aims of the project.
10. Under the terms of data protection laws, you have the right to access your personal data and the right to rectify, delete or limit data processing, the right to object to the processing and the right to data transfer. In addition, you have the right to lodge a complaint to the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection when you feel that the processing of personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR.
11. To the extent that the processing takes place on the basis of consent, you also have the right to withdraw consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of the processing which was carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.
12. Your personal data will not be subject to automatic decision making or profiling.
